
Kieran Foley:

Midfield. 'The Beautiful One'. Excellent tackler with great strength and stamina. Just returned from Chad and still acclimatising to the Irish weather.



Eddie Movnihan Fullback/winger. Great dribbler and loves to take on players. Scored a vital goal against Blackstone Rovers in the quarter finals.






