GIRLS ACADEMY – JANUARY 2013 UPDATE

Training:

Our indoor weekly training re-commenced on Thursday January 10th last with the continued great and enthusiastic support from our Under 8's, 10's, and 12 girls. Details on our training schedule can be viewed on our website under our girls section. It's great to see a steady increase in numbers attending our under 8 academy section.

Blitzes: (Under 10 & 12's)

It's our intention to continue to participate in the indoor blitzes coordinated by our league, Cork Women's & Schoolgirls Soccer League (CWSSL), in the Sports Village on the Model Farm Road. There are no direct entry costs involved to families for these events & they are certainly worth while from a squad/team building & comradeship point of view and also gets us interacting with other Clubs. With the rules involved in "futsal" events it will also assist with our overall skill levels. We will bring a maximum squad of 10 per event, as games are 6 a side. As per our written notification given to all at training during January, we will rotate our entire girl's academy squad members to ensure everyone gets equal time throughout the season for these worthy competitions.





GIRLS LEAGUE: (UNDER 12'S)

As you are aware the Club entered this season our first competitive under age girls team to compete in a league run by the Cork Women's & Schoolgirls Soccer League (C.W.S.S.L.) This was a huge jump for us as our girls academy has really only taken off over the past 2 years in a very non competitive way but we believe in this decision that it will stand to us in the next 1-2 years as the majority of the squad will still be eligible for this under 12 category. Our numbers attending both home & away games has been truly fantastic & we thank all families for their commitment weekly.

Our league is a 9 a side competition and permits a number of substitutions to be brought on/off at any given time .As you may have witnessed, due to the great attendances at games we have had to rotate our entire team to accommodate every player's participation at some stage, which incidentally has been Club policy since the creation of our underage academy structure back in 2004.We find this unfair to all concerned and as a result will create two squads, which will be rotated from game to game.

The majority of our under 12 squad presently is made up of 8 & 9 year olds who are competing against 10 & 11 year olds in league games which is reflected in our results, nothing we can do here as other clubs have simply been established longer that Watergrasshill United.

So going forward, effective immediately, we will be sending out text messages to families for certain games ensuring however that ALL girls get fair play/game time throughout the season.

We hope you understand & appreciate the above as we continue at all times to have the interests of our girl academy members in mind. Of course we welcome any feedback from parents/guardians

Development Pamoja - "Our colleagues in Kenya", by James Hennessy

Development Pamoja is a community based organisation working in the Rift Valley in Kenya. Our main focus is empowering communities to become self-sufficient. Since 2010 we have provided zero interest loans to people in the district of Mogotio, enabling them to start small businesses. In the past two years we have begun to focus on assisting local farmers, particularly subsistence farmers, who only produce enough to survive. In 2012 we started a demonstration farm showing local people how to harvest rain water, as water is an issue in the area. We introduced new farming techniques such as drip irrigation to the area. Our aim is that local people will start to replicate these farming techniques which will increase their own productivity and in turn ensure that local farmers and their families no longer rely on aid. The farm also provides employment for people in the local community.



Apart from providing loans and working with local farmers Development Pamoja also implements social projects. At present we are testing people in the Mogotio district for HIV/AIDS to help prevent the virus from claiming more lives. Within this project we also educate people on how to live with HIV/AIDS and care for people suffering from the illness. We also promote the rights of

those living with HIV/AIDS and show the community at large that people living with HIV/AIDS still contribute positively to society.

With the help of Watergrasshill United we also work closely with a local football team Athinai Football Club. David Okinja and James Hennessy who work with Development Pamoja assist with coaching the senior team. The season in runs with Kenva the calendar. In 2012 we finished fifth in a league of seventeen teams and will be hoping for an improved performance in 2013.



As Development Pamoja we would like to take this opportunity to thank members of Watergrasshill United and the parish of Watergrasshill and Glenville as a whole who have been very supportive of our work to date.
